






### Owl Craft

1. First, print out the papers needed to create your owl. You can choose any color you would like to for the owl and its features.










2. After, cut out the pieces of the owl. The lines of the cut outs are thick to allow for any cutting mistakes.










3. Glue the circles together in size order to make the eyes for the owl.

9. Use markers to add feathers to the owl's body







